Photo Imaging introduces students to photographic equipment, materials, processes and composition as they relate to black and white photography providing a thorough understanding of technical aspects of the camera, black and white film development and basic dark-room procedures. Students are encouraged to use the fine art of photography for individual expression, as well as the technical process for career preparation. Students completing this program develop advanced critical thinking, applied academic, business, economic and leadership skills required for entry into Photo Imaging occupations. Advanced students continue to develop and expand technical and artistic skills with emphasis on photo journalism, digital print manipulations, studio experience, professional portfolio presentation and color photography. Students have the opportunity to photograph, develop and print images to be used in the yearbook, newspaper and a variety of school publications.
